





How many lives saved so far since they hit the ground running to provide urgent treatment for the seriously affected measles patients is secondary to the Australian Medical Assistant Team, (AUSMAT).

Paramount to the Australian Samarians is saving lives.

And those touched by their miracle work are singing praises.

"They (Australian team) are the best. I want to thank them from the bottom of my heart for saving my daughter," says an emotional Moana Oli from Vaimoso whose one year daughter is in stable condition after she was admitted to the make shift Intensive Care Unit set up the Australian team to the provide lifesaving treatment and to assist with increasing number of patients mostly young children since the Measles Epidemic was declared.

Mrs. Oli said her daughter was rushed to the hospital last Saturday night with severe pneumonia symptoms.

"We were so worried because I could see that my daughter could

Patriotic citizens step up to support drive against Measles

From a hot meal, to children's diapers and even appliances for the drive to detain the Measles Epidemic is amazing for three patriot women.

The three are overwhelmed with the outpour of public support

Completely from difference backgrounds they share one goal and one mission; to provide support for the frontline workers enduring the long hours to provide health care and to provide essentials needed by the young measles patients and their families.

In the appliances and equipment department, Mrs Audrey Petaia is the Coordinator organising equipment and accessories such infusion pumps, ventilation equipment etc. direly need by National Hospitals Intensive Care Unit.

Mrs Clara Ah Kuoi and her group are concentrating on collecting blankets, food and accessories for the children and their families.

And lastly but not the least, former ACEO with the Ministry of Prime Minister and Cabinet Renate Rivers is putting her experience as a First Respondent during Natural Disasters to lend a helping hand

through their family restaurant and catering business.

And their ingenuity to use Facebook to seek public support is rewarded.

Rivers and her mother Lena Rivers are able to cater hot meals for hospital staff since Monday and through donations from the public, they have enough food supplies to commit to cook, prepare and distribute one meal per day until Sunday.

"We're doing it not for the praises nor to profile our business but genuinely to help."

"It's the thought that counts," said Rivers. "Instead of just complaining why not do something positive for the people who deserves that little recognition as a way of saying Thank You," she said.

That something is not small with the hot meals delivered to the frontline staff at the hospital as well as APCC Unit, the Main Centre for Measles Acute 7's Isolation Ward and the HDU Ward.

Rivers is fully aware that many a times, the public servants sacrificing their time and giving their best to provide services in times of disasters are overlooked and unappreciated.

And it prompted her with her mother and family's support to be

part of the solution and not the problem.

"Watching videos and seeing pictures on Facebook really moved me and I guess you can say God has put so much compassion in me for the people that are affected, so I messaged a friend at the hospital offering to help," says Mrs. Ah Kuoi.

From there, she started her own Facebook SOS for assistance and the response like what the Rivers have experience is nothing short than "overwhelming."

And up till now, she is still "running around collecting and picking up donations for the children and their families at the hospital."

On Monday, Mrs Ah Kuoi and her team donated a hot water boiler for the Paediatric Ward and distributed diapers to each of the children patients.

And she is calling on the country for their prayers.

"Please keep our doctors, nurses and hospital Staff in your Prayers. A big Thank you also to the Australian Doctors and Nurses who flew over to help at Motootua during this time," she said. "We need to stand together as a Nation."

barely breathe. And we brought her here and these good Samaritans with God's help managed to help her and treated her," said a thankful mother of nine.

"Today, I can see that she is getting better since last Saturday.

"I'm not worried anymore and I put my trust and faith in the hands of these good doctors and nurses who are here day and night assisting our sick."

And Grandmother Maria Motusaga peaceful smile of relief is a telling story.

"When we brought my granddaughter she was not breathing and this team immediately attended to her," recalls Mrs. Motusaga.

She said five Doctors and nurses attended to her child immediately when they arrived.

"Now her coughing is gone and her breathing is a lot better."

"She is better than when arrived over the weekend and I pray to God to continue his healing power on her. I can see that she is better now."

Mrs. Motusaga said this is the youngest of her four grandchildren.

"I want to thank the Australian Government and their medical team for their help in taking care of my child."

"I also want to advise our Ministry of Health that the lives of our children is in their hands and the love and healing power of God comes through their profession and services."

To all the parents, the thankful grandmother of four is calling on the country to pray for those who have been unfortunate to contract measles. And she sends her condolences to the grieving families of loved ones who have lost their lives as a result of the epidemic.

AUSMAT is deployed to provide clinical support, hospital capability and urgent medical equipment and supplies, including a portable eight bed intensive care unit, to bolster the capacity of the Samoan health system.

"Australian health specialists will continue to

work with local counterparts to ensure the Samoan health system is able to meet ongoing patient needs," says Australian High Commissioner to Samoa Sara Moriarty.

"Australia is working closely with the Government of Samoa, the World Health Organization, the Government of New Zealand and other regional partners to coordinate our response efforts and prevent the further spread of measles."

The swift response by Australia and New Zealand which has also dispatched urgently needed assistance is commended by Health Minister Faimalotoa Kika Stowers Ah Kau.

"In our time of need, Australia, New Zealand and our international partners have come to the aid of our people and on behalf of the Government,

Prime Minister, Cabinet and the People of Samoa, we thank you abundantly," complimented the Minister.

Samoa is in a State of Emergency with officials on the move to roll out a Mass Vaccination Program coupled with a number of orders mandated by law to minimize any further loss of life from the dreaded Measle Epidemic.

Mandatory vaccination in the works

By January 2020, there should be a legislative mandate in place requiring all children to be vaccinated or immunized before they are allowed to attend school. And the compulsory requirement will apply to all schools which includes public, church and private school.

The directive was approved by Cabinet this week with the Office of the Attorney General tasked to draft legislations to this effect to be tabled in the next parliament session schedule for December.

In revealing the proposed legislation Prime Minister Tuilaepa Sailele Malielegaoi says that the legislative mandate is the best alternative to protect Samoa from future epidemics.

"A national enforcement of mandatory vaccination will reduce local outbreaks, morbidity, and mortality associated with vaccine-preventable diseases," says the Prime Minister.

"Mandating vaccination against childhood diseases like polio, diphtheria, and measles, will make it compulsory for all school-aged children to get vaccinated. "And no proof of vaccination, no school enrolment," he reiterated.

The Prime Minister told reporters that the alarming residential low coverage rate of the vaccination drive aimed at resisting infectious and deadly diseases such as the present Measles Epidemic is more than enough reason to justify the Cabinet initiative.

And the decision he added is also prompted from latest immunization statistics tabled before Cabinet. Those numbers shows that 60% of the population have received vaccination injections leaving over 100,000 unvaccinated.

"But with a binding law in place, there will be no room for excuses," added the Prime Minister.

Presently, Government is fine tuning the process for a Mass Vaccination Campaign eyeing the most vulnerable areas as a priority where data shows a high rate of unvaccinated residents.

Tropical Cyclones threat looms over Samoa

As if the Measles Epidemic is not enough, Samoa is on notice based on weather predictions that three Tropical Cyclones (TC) will be heading to the Samoa region between now and April 2020.

The forecast is included in the Climate Change Report Card compiled by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment, (MNRE) and tabled before the Cabinet Development Committee in its meeting this month.

"Two to three Cyclones are predicted to pass within 400km radius of the Samoa region with at least one tropical cyclone to reach Category 3 (wind speed at least 178 km/hr to 111miles/hr) or greater (Category 4 to Category 5)," reads the report.

And MNRE's Chief Executive Ulu Bismarck Crawley has assured the CDC and its chairman Prime Minister Tuilaepa Sailele Malielegaoi that the Sector is making preparations to anticipate the worst.

"We are preparing for the worse scenario with the objective to

keep our country informed," said Ulu.

In the last two decades, Tropical Cyclones have not only cost millions in damages but also loss of life for many local residents.

The largest were the 1990 Cyclone Ofa followed by the 1991 Cyclone Val in December. The two natural disasters left behind a bill of over \$1 billion tala in damages.

In December 2012 Tropical Cyclone Evan's uninvited visit to Samoa left a trail of \$465 million tala in damages.

And the last Cyclone to invade Samoa came in 2018 with the country inheriting damages in the neighborhood of \$2.5 million tala.

Also contained in the report are other project developments.

For instance, the Afolau Biomass Gasification Plant.

The project is designed to improve the performance and reliability of Renewable Energy Power Systems in Samoa classified as the IMPRESS project.

Constructions started in July 2015 with February 2020 targeted as the commission date.

It is co-funded by the Global Environment Facility (GEF) Trust Fund and the United Nations Development Programme.

For readers who are not aware of the CDC, the Cabinet Development Committee meeting – or the CDC as known in public service circles, it is the most important committee in the whole of government.

It involves the Cabinet and all government chief executives and assistant chief executive representation. The committee meets every two months.

Major projects are introduced at this meeting and progress reports on various projects and programmes are also tabled before it.

There are also times when the CDC goes on field trips to inspect first-hand how government projects are progressing.

And the inspection is crucial for the government to check if the projects' progress are proceeding on schedule and should there be any hick-ups government must take immediate actions.

Further support from NZ for measles outbreak

(GOVT. OF NEW ZEALAND); New Zealand's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Affairs Minister Vaovasamanaia Winston Peters has announced further support as the Government of Samoa responds to a serious measles outbreak.

"New Zealand will deploy a further 18 vaccination nurses, bringing the total to 30 working in Samoa over the next four weeks," said Vaovasamanaia in a Press Statement.

"A New Zealand Medical Assistance Team (NZMAT) of ten doctors and nurses and support staff will deploy to Apia early tomorrow."

"On 15 November the Government of Samoa declared a State of Emergency as the numbers of people infected with measles continues to rise and the hospital system is under strain.

"We fully support Samoa's efforts to immunise its population, contain the outbreak, and treat patients who are ill."

"The vaccination nurses will support Samoa's immunisation programme, which is targeting the most at risk populations."

"The medical assistance team will support Samoan health personnel, providing treatment and medical supplies in a district hospital on Upolu that is facing heavy demand due to the outbreak."

The support announced Monday this week is in addition to the deployment of 12 vaccination nurses, vaccines and medical supplies New Zealand committed to Samoa last week.



RSE, the triple win combination

New Zealand's Recognized Seasonal Employer Scheme (aka RSE) is a triple win, win, win for Samoa's seasonal workers, our communities and the New Zealand employers.

But the triple win comes with great expectations for our workers recruited under the RSE, warns the New Zealand High Commissioner to Samoa, His Excellency Dr. Trevor Matheson.

In his address to the Samoa Labour Mobility Programs earlier this month at TATTE Conference Room, he acknowledged the contribution by Samoan RSE workers to New Zealand's economy and also touched on the benefits and challenges of the scheme.

"What we want is for workers to go to New Zealand to succeed. To operate at 100 percent to the extent that you can base on your skills and your health," said Mr Matheson.

"And if you can do that, we do get the win, win, win. The triple win for you as a worker, the win for your employer and the win for the community and the

national economy of Samoa.

"You represent the future of this nation (Samoa), but you also represent part of the future of my nation (New Zealand). And hand in hand I want to see a better stronger New Zealand and I also want to see a better stronger Samoa moving forward where we work harmonious together benefiting each other and the regional seasonal employment scheme is one of those schemes that enhances both our countries' economies, our peoples, and our future."

Over 2000 Samoan workers are employed in the New Zealand horticulture and viticulture industry. Last year, the RSE program had 1,800 Samoans on their payroll. And the increase is attributed by the New Zealand High Commissioner to Samoans excellent reputation as hardworking, honest and law

abiding.

"Moreover," he continued, "your Christian upbringing is also widely admired. These attributes are the types of attributes that New Zealand employers are seeking in harnessing the resources of Samoa to travel to New Zealand.

"I take my hat off to all those who've travelled to New Zealand over the last 12 years under the RSE scheme," he complimented.

"You have set a standard that you can be proud of. And as the Prime Minister has mentioned this morning, you need to continue to meet that standard, and those RSE workers who follow in the footsteps of many who have done so over the last 12 years, have a high standard to uphold and to continue to improve to the benefit of your communities."

And the annual gap for Seasonal

Workers from the nine Pacific Forum countries is slowly and surely increasing.

Elaborated Dr. Matheson;

"That gap at the beginning was limited to only 5000. Has grown substantially since then, and October this year, its 14,400 but lots of NZ employers believe that that gap is still too low and they continue to lobby the Government to increase the gap going forward and Government has undertaken to again look at the gap next year to take it over 15,000 and further as we move forward."

Overall and based on study in 2017 of 264 Samoan workers, it revealed that they remitted a total of NZ\$6 million to Samoa, mostly through remittances and the remaining in cash or in kind.

He noted that the cost of transmit-

ting remittances in the Pacific is costly compared to other parts of the world. This is both because of the rapidly smaller sums of money remitted and the lack of competitiveness in the remittance market.

It's an issue he said the New Zealand Government recognizes and is working together with New Zealand banks Pacific banks to bring the flow of remittances down, to meet the sustainable development goals, he said..

For Government, they have enforced strict policies to ensure that the RSE Program and similar employment programs in Australia are not compromised and may jeopardize job openings for Samoans.

The Ministry of Commerce Industry and Labour ('Ministry') Department role under the Occupational Safety and Health Act 2002 is to enhance the productivity, morale and welfare of people at work and people affected by work activity by way of promoting the safety, health and welfare of people at work; and protecting other persons against risks to health or safety arising out of or in connection with work activities.

The Ministry in partnership with the Ministry of Health ('MOH'), following the declaration over the Measles Epidemic wish to remind;

- All employers or managerial personal of their duty of care to take all reasonable practicable steps to protect the safety, health and welfare at work of employees and workers to provide and maintain a safe and healthy working environment including substances, systems of work and any building or public or private area in which work takes place; and
- All employees and workers must take all reasonable care to protect his or her health and safety at work, and, of fellow workers and, as appropriate, other persons in the vicinity,

All employers and employees, in the public and private sectors, must take heed of the following precautions and safety measures in their workplace as advice from the Ministry of Health to minimize the spread of the measles virus.

Initial measles symptoms include:

- A high fever,
- Cough,
- Runny nose, and
- Red and watery eyes as well as, eye sensitivity to light

After 3-5 days, a raised red rash will start to appear on the head, face and body.

For those who have any of the above symptoms:

1. Isolation at home is strongly recommended
2. It is important to keep hydrated by drinking lots of fluid
3. Take panadol or, for children paracetamol syrup, if experiencing a fever and apply cool sponging and it is important to keep hydrated by drinking lots of fluid
4. Cover your nose and mouth when sneezing or coughing or, wear a mask.
5. Keep children at home if they are not well and/or experience any of the above measles symptoms.
6. Stay home and away from public areas or work if you have any of the measles symptoms noted above.
7. Seek medical advice if you or your child's condition becomes worse.

The Ministry of Health continues to advise the public to take preventative measures to protect themselves and their families from contacting measles.

The Ministry advises the public to:

1. Avoid crowded living environments and, to refrain from being in places where there a lot of people or large gatherings.
2. To minimize any spread of germs by covering your nose and mouth when sneezing or coughing or, wear a mask
3. Keep children at home if there are not well
4. Stay home and away from public areas if you are not well.
5. Ensure that children's vaccination and immunization status is kept up to date.
6. Ensure that children 6 months and above are vaccinated, if they have not been vaccinated.
7. Keep hydrated by drinking lots of fluid.
8. Do not share bedding, clothing or drinks etc.
9. At work and at home ensure that you maintain good hand washing practices by washing your hands using soap and clean water several times throughout the day and, after coughing, sneezing or, caring for a sick person.

Some of the people who should not be vaccinated with the current measles vaccine includes; infants less than 6 months of age, pregnant women, people with compromised immune systems and people with a history of allergic reaction to the vaccine




